"There is no such thing as a Part-Shagya-Arabian!"

Regardless what has been published or claimed by the other Shagya association in North America – fact is and fact remains – there is no such thing as a Part-Shagya-Arabian. ANY registration and classification of horses as Part-Shagya-Arabian is incorrect. Looking back even to previous versions of the ISG Studbook regulations (1992) and going back even before ISG was founded – **NOWHERE exists a category or classification of a Shagya crossed with a Purebred Arabian as a Part-Shagya-Arabian.**

It is obvious that it is not easy to acknowledge that a huge mistake was made when the concept of Part-Shagya Arabians was introduced into North America several years ago! Holding on to a wrong registration concept/model is even more questionable. The recent changes ("liberalization") in the ISG Studbook regulations have NOTHING to do in that matter. There are many examples of a Shagya crossed with a Purebred Arabian, which were registered as Shagyas in the related section of the Studbook or Studbook Appendix in the past. This was the case before and while the old/previous ISG Studbook regulation was in place, and still is today, after the ISG rules have been updated to comply with some of the European rules and regulations.

Purebred Arabian mares were used in Shagya breeding as long as they were recognized by the WAHO and were inspected. The offspring of those were registered as Shagyas.

Here is just one example from one of the official German Studbooks where everyone can see and verify for him/herself that Purebred Arabian mares were used in Shagya breeding and the resulting Off-Spring were NOT called/classified as "Part-Shagya-Arabian". The off-spring even went into the **Main-Studbook as Shagya.**

The statement: "The ISG breeding rules up until May of 2007 maintained that offspring of Purebred Arabian mares could not be registered as Purebred Shagyas" therefore is misleading/wrong.

To summarize and to keep it simple:

How can one say they are and always were in compliance with ISG rules – if there is just no such category or classification as a Part-Shagya-Arabian?

ASAV continues to be committed to issue correct registration papers and being an open, membership friendly, democratic organization, which has bound itself to a correct Shagya registry for all Shagya-Arabian bloodstock in North America.
