

**Marek x** has completed two stallion tests. The first was with the VZAP in Neustadt/Dosse for which he was awarded a 7,92. At the other one, he proved himself successful during a 70-day test in Marbach, finishing fourth in a field of warmblood stallions with an overall index of 112,91. His exceptional character - for which he was rewarded with a perfect 10 - deserves special attention.

Marek x is a large-framed **Anglo-Arabian Thoroughbred** with good caliber, magnificent jumping ability and excellent type. He was approved in 1998 as vice champion and offers the best of performance blood: His Purebred Arabian grandfather Pedro won his stallion test in Medingen and was a multiple champion. His mother, Elite Mare Mona x, was a junior champion in Altenstadt.

In 2002, Marek x was European champion at the European Sports Championships for Arabian Horses in Babolna, Hungary. He has also competed successfully in dressage and eventing up to German level L, being highly placed and having won at numerous occasions. In show jumping, he is victorious up to German level M.

Marek x is a safe choice for producing best performing offspring. He has two approved sons, of which Ismahn x was awarded a premium at the ZSAA-approval in 2009. His daughters are highly successful in breeding and performance tests.

In recognition of his breeding value and his own performance accomplishments, Marek x was rewarded by the VZAP with the title of an **Elite Stallion**. He has held first place in the German Anglo-Arabian breeding statistics many times in recent history, and it is safe to say that he has had a considerable impact on the population.

As an Arabian stallion he is in a class of his own.

He consistently passes on to his offspring his charming character and his unsurpassed temper, both of which were rewarded with a perfect 10.

His aptitude, riding quality and his jumping were highly praised and received grades from 9 through 9,5.

In Arabian breeding, he stands for improvement of riding quality, and he has proven his refinement to warmblood populations, offering the desired qualities of Arabian horses. In combination with endless jumping ability and excellent gaits, this makes him unique in his usage, and he is an outstanding genetic outcross for all breeds without questioning the accomplishments of sports horse breeding.

Because of his pedigree, Puschkin proves to be especially valuable to Shagya breeding, as even offspring out of Purebred Arabian mares will fulfill the 7/16 studbook requirements. Puschkin has four approved sons, numerous premium mare daughters and winners of performance tests. Among his offspring are many successful sports horses and those of any color.
