Portrait of HERAKLES TSF

The grey gelding Herakles TSF was born at the Trakehner stud farm of Lore and Horst Tessner in Germany in 1993. He is a son of the **Shagya Arabian Ghazzir Sh.A**. and comes from a Trakehner Mare Family that was founded by the mare Heimische by **Gazal Sh.A**. It is not unusual for a modern Trakehner sport horse to carry some Shagya blood, and in fact, the introduction of Shagya Arabian blood into the Trakehner breed started over 100 years ago and is still often a route to success today.

Herakles' dam was Hera by the famous Trakehner elite stallion Consul – himself an Anglo Trakehner by the excellent thoroughbred stallion Swazi xx. A closer look at Herakles' pedigree shows the high amount of special blood he carries. And that in turn predisposed him to become an above average eventer.

Herakles' career began in 1998, when he was trained by the German Olympic eventer Andreas Dibowski. In 1999, he took the promising youngster to the German National Championships for Young Event Horses (called the Bundeschampionat) – the biggest and toughest young horse event in the world. Herakles did very well and would have ended up high in the final rankings if his rider had not neglected to cross the finish line. In 2000, Herakles was introduced to international competition and did well at the CCI* level. He placed 8th at Bialo Bor in Poland, and was 3rd at Intermediate in Sahrendorf (Germany) and 4th in Princehagen (The Netherlands). In 2001, he placed at CIC**s, among others in Berlin-Hoppegarten and Biefeld, and won Team Gold at the CCIO** in Bonn-Roddernberg as part of the German team. With his rider, he also finished 7th in this prestigious event. Herakles TSF continuously showed at the CCI*** level from 2002 throughout 2007, and switched riders when Elmar Lesch took over. He qualified the gelding for the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens with a win at the CCI*** Bialo Bor (Poland) and since 2007, Herakles TSF serves as the "schoolmaster" mount for German Young Rider Christoph Wahler, who continues to show the energetic gelding at international levels throughout Europe.

In many ways, Herakles embodies the perfect blend of substantial Trakehner and TB lines with the endurance and nobility that comes from the Shagya. He is a horse with many years and even more miles under his belt, yet still impresses with outstanding cross country rounds and the much admired ability to stay sound and healthy under the most demanding of circumstances. And it is his inner quality and his intelligence that makes him a perfect match for a young rider in one of the toughest sports around!
